## RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entries are free and open to members of Societies affiliated with the Orchid Society of NSW, and are subject to its rules and bylaws.

2. Plants benched must have been owned and grown by the exhibitor for at least six months preceding the Show.

3. Entries are to be benched from 3pm to 6pm Friday 6<sup>th</sup> September and 6.30am to 7.30am Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> September, 2024. Exhibitors will receive a series of numbered labels for each of the plants to be exhibited. Entries are accepted on the condition they are free from disease and pests.

4. All exhibits, when benched, will be under the control and direction of the Show Marshal and no plants can be removed during the Show period. Plants cannot be removed until after the presentation of awards is completed.

5. The Show Marshal's decision on the interpretation of the show rules shall be final.

6. Judges are appointed by the Orchid Society of NSW Inc. Judges' decisions are final.7. In the event of either an insufficient or excess number of entries in any Class then, at the discretion of the Show Marshal, Classes may be deleted or added and any affected entries moved to another Class as determined by the Show Marshal.

8. Entries are accepted on the basis that the Society shall take reasonable care of the exhibits, and exhibitors shall have no claim against the organisers, Society or Sponsors.

9. An Australian Native Orchid is as defined in the Australian Orchid Council's [AOC] Guidelines for Judging Handbook.

10. A Novice ceases to be a Novice after winning any prize in any section of a judged show.

11. All plants presented for sale must be free from disease and pests, affixed with CHOS

identification tags and price. The plants should be established.

NSW Native Orchids must be tagged using the CHOS Licence.

12. First Flowering Seedling must have been grown from seed and be flowering for the first time.
13. First place in Novice and First Flowering Seedling categories will be eligible for the open competition. Others will be moved at the discretion of the Judging Panel.
