They do not need to be in flower. A photograph will often help your sales efforts and if possible they should have a detailed label attached.

The Society will not collect any commission at these two monthly meetings. Remember, if you want a quick sale then price the plant accordingly. If you are selling natives to other members then they do <u>not</u> require a licence tag.

This year you can sell plants other than orchids.

10. PERTH INTERNATIONAL ORCHID CONFERENCE AND SHOW, 2024

Orchids Western Australia (OrchidsWA) and the Orchid Specialist Group of the IUCN invite you to attend the inaugural Perth International Orchid Conference & Show (Perth IOCS) incorporating two significant international orchid events, the 23rd Australian Orchid Council (AOC) Conference & Show and the 8th International Orchid Conservation Congress (IOCC) being staged in Perth, Western Australia from 11 to 16 September 2024.
