EDITORIAL:

As soon as members of the public walked into the Show Room at this year's Spring Show, there were gasps of delight and exclamations about the wonderous flowers that filled the Show Room at the Coffs Harbour Botanic Gardens. Not only were there spectacular flowers on the Champions' table but on every bench there were amazing examples of the plants from the fascinating world of orchids.

This year's Show saw a wide variety of orchids benched and pleasant weather saw good attendance from the public. This edition of the newsletter features the highlights of the 2024 Spring Show.

196 plants were benched by 16 growers and these provided a colourful display. It seems the orchid season was two or three weeks earlier than in 2023,so different varieties of orchids were entered when compared to last year's Show.

The Grand Champion Ribbon and Trophy was again sponsored this year by Rosella Orchids from South Grafton. This was awarded to Malcolm Ide for his outstanding green cascading *Cymbidium* Marcia Pettijohn 'Long Legs'.

The Reserve Champion Ribbon and Trophy went to Rhonda Smith for her spectacular *Dendrobium* Mousmee. This eye-catching hybrid was awarded the Champion Specimen of the Show and also received a cultural award from the Judges. In addition, Rhonda's plant was selected by the visiting public for the Popular Vote Award.

A pictorial report of the Grand, Reserve and Specimen Champions as well as the Champions of each Section of the Show is included in this newsletter. Congratulations to these growers on their excellent orchids.

We thank the Judges for their expertise and commitment to carrying out this important task. Thank you also to the North Coast Regional Botanic Gardens for the use of their venue and for their cooperation in the running of this Show.

The staging of each Show would not be possible without the significant hours of hard work contributed by our members. Thank you to everyone for their assistance, cooperation and enthusiasm. Excellent work!

'Well no' conceded the assistant.


'So the Irishman says 'Well, alright then, why did you ask me if I'm Irish just because I asked for Irish sausages?'



CHOS SUPPLIES OF ORCHID BARK: NEW SUPPLIES—FRESH BARK JUST ARRIVED

The CHOS now has a NEW supply of Kiwi Bark and Charcoal. Kiwi Orchid Bark is a hard, clean, uniformly graded *Pinus radiata* bark suitable for growing orchids. Due to price rises The Society has had to increase to price of 50 litre bags and these now sell for **\$50 each.**

Kiwi bark comes in four sizes— No.2: **3 to 8mm**; No.3: **8 to 20mm**; No.4: **20 to 25mm**; No. 5: **25 to**

50mm. Supplies of 15mm charcoal (Orchid Char) are also available.

These are in 19kg bags and sell at \$45 per bag.
